DEADLY TORNADOES DEVASTATE COMMUNITIES IN ARKANSAS, OKLAHOMA, AND KANSAS

Nazarene Compassionate Ministries

Nazarene Disaster Response

Last Sunday evening a storm tore through parts of Arkansas, Oklahoma and Kansas, spawning tornadoes that left 17 dead, many injured and entire neighborhoods destroyed.

The Vilonia (Arkansas) First Church of the Nazarene was among the buildings damaged. Three years ago, another tornado destroyed the church's sanctuary. The church had just completed their rebuilding project and had worshipped in their new building only twice before Sunday's storm hit.

Across town, Pastor Kevin Rector, pastor of the Liberty Church of the Nazarene and former Olivet classmate of Pastor Brad, huddled with his family in a storm shelter awaiting the tornado's passing. They emerged from the shelter to discover the storm had destroyed their home. Family photos would later be found over 125 miles from the Rector home.

Nazarene Disaster Response is already working to help. Our own NDR volunteers are awaiting the call to go and help with recovery efforts. We know already that **Crisis Care Kits** will be needed.

- 1 Shampoo (12 to 18 oz)
- 2 Bars of Soap (bath size or larger)
- 1 Toothpaste (3.0 to 6.4 oz)
- 3 Toothbrushes (in original packaging)
- 1 Box of Band-aids (30 or more)
- 1 Fingernail Clippers
- 1 Sturdy hair comb
- 2 Hand Towels
- 4 Pocket-sized pkgs Kleenex
- 2 Gallon zip-lock bags

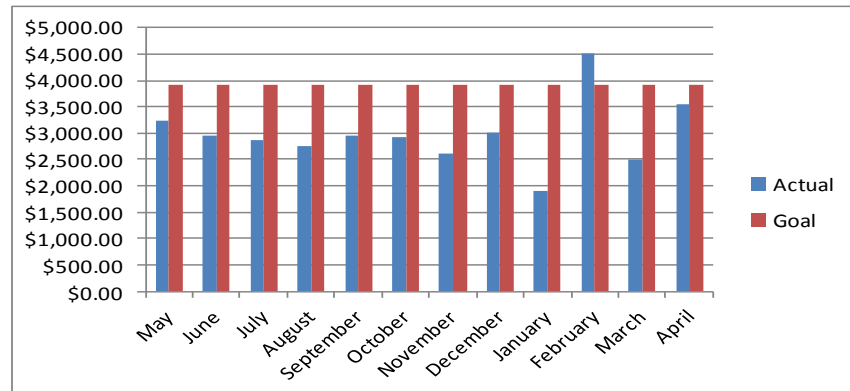
